



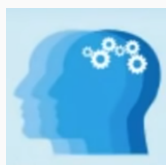

European National Young Academies Met in Helsinki

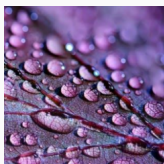

Got Energy Talent: Up to 21 Postdoctoral Fellowships Available- 2nd Call



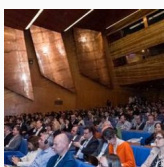
