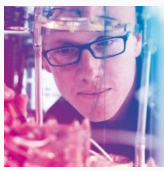
Application for the European Union Commission Blue Book Traineeships is Open Now

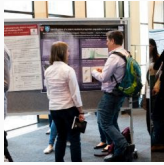
39 Early Stage Researcher Positions in QUSTEC – Doctoral Training Programme
